AGREED ORDER OF COMPROMISE, SETTLEMENT, AND DISMISSAL.

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between Jonathan Davidson (the defendant) and the United States, as evidenced by the signature of the parties below as follows:

1. The United States filed a lawsuit on July 18, 2012 seeking relief of \$7,299.10 plus accruing daily interest for unpaid student loans.
2. The Defendant-Debtor in this matter, Jonathan Davidson, has appeared *pro se*.
3. The parties have negotiated a deal whereby the Defendant will make monthly installment payments toward reduction of the debt, which the Defendant acknowledges as due and owing.
4. The intent to enter into this agreement is demonstrated by the signatures of the parties below.

THEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The stipulations set forth above are incorporated herein as findings of the Court.
2. Beginning October 15, 2012, the Defendant will pay to the United States fifty dollars (\$50.00) per month by the 15th day of each month until the debt is extinguished.

3. No interest will be charged the Defendant so long as the Defendant pays no less than \$50.00 per month by the fifteenth of each month beginning October 15, 2012 until the debt is extinguished.

4. However, should the Defendant pay less than the amount provided and at the time provided in Item #2, *supra*, the Defendant will be required to pay the remaining balance with interest at the current post-judgment rate, from the date of the first missed installment until paid.

5. In the event of default in the payment of any installments when due as provided herein, the United States may, without notice or demand, declare the entire remaining unpaid balance immediately due and payable.

6. Payments shall be made in either a personal check, cashiers check or money order and made payable to the United States Department of Justice. Checks may be mailed to the United States Attorney's Office or to the following address: United States Department of Justice, P. O. Box 790363, St. Louis, MO 63179-0363. Please ensure that your account number 3:12-cv-0740, is listed on your check or money order to ensure proper credit. All inquiries regarding payments should be addressed to the United States Attorney's Office Financial Litigation Unit at 615-736-5151.


7. The above-captioned action is hereby dismissed with prejudice.

8. At the request of the parties, this Court shall retain jurisdiction to enforce any and all terms and conditions of the settlement agreement.
