AGREED JUDGMENT ENTRY

NOW COMES Defendant, RBS Citizens Bank, N.A., ("Citizens ") by and through its attorney, Keri P. Ebeck, and Plaintiffs, Amanda Marie Opp ("Plaintiff") by and through their attorney, Clair M. Stewart, and hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

1. The debt due and owing by Plaintiff to Citizens is nondischargeable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. Section 523(a)(8) of the United States Bankruptcy Code in the amount of \$37,000 together with interest at the rate of 5% per annum from the date of judgment.

2. Plaintiff agrees to pay the principal sum of \$37,000 together with interest at 0% per annum from the date of judgment at a minimum of \$75 per month. The first payment is due on June 15, 2013 and then the minimum payments are due on or before the 15th day of each month thereafter, until such time as \$37,000 has been paid.

3. Execution on the judgment shall be stayed against Plaintiff provided Plaintiff pays at least the sum of \$75 on June 15, 2013, and then pays at least \$75 on or before the 15th day of

each month thereafter, until such time as \$37,000 has been paid. As long as timely and full payments are made, the payments shall apply to the sum of \$37,000 and all interest shall be waived. There shall be no penalty for pre-payment of the judgment amount.





Should Plaintiff default in any provision of this Agreement or default in the repayment of the debt at any time, then the full amount of the nondischargeable balance with credit for payments made shall become immediately due and owing, with interest accrued from the date of judgment, and Citizens is free to exercise its rights in accordance with state law.


