


1. National Collegiate Student Loan Trust is joined as a defendant in this action;
2. National Collegiate Student Loan Trust is deemed served the complaint;
3. National Collegiate Student Loan Trust warrants that it, solely, is the holder of the education loan obligations which are the subject of this proceeding no other entity other than National Collegiate Student Loan Trust, specifically AES/PHEAA, possess a present or a foreseeable interest in this obligation. Rather, AES/PHEAA acted as servicer of this obligation
4. That the educational loan made or insured by National Collegiate Student Loan Trust against Plaintiff Aileen Gleason in the sum of approximately \$8,750.00 for an educational loan is hereby deemed dischargeable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §523(a)(8) and discharged against Plaintiff Aileen Gleason. Any and all claims of National Collegiate Student Loan Trust and/or its servicer Defendant AES/PHEAA aka American Education Services/ Pennsylvania Education Assistance Agency regarding the above mentioned educational loan are subject to the provisions of 11 U.S.C. §524.
5. By entry of this order, Plaintiff Aileen Gleason's adversary proceeding is effectively resolved as to National Collegiate Student Loan Trust and AES/PHEAA.
