Dear Mr. Pinkston,

On October 1, 2012, the bankruptcy court dismissed your adversary proceeding and asked our local counsel, Madeleine Wanslee, and ECMC to assist you in applying to the William D. Ford Direct Loan Consolidation Program's Income-Based Repayment plan. On October 16, 2012, ECMC sent you a pre-populated application and other forms necessary to apply for the IBR and asked that you return the forms to ECMC for processing.

To date, we have not received anything from you. As a courtesy, I am enclosing another application to complete and return to ECMC for processing. Please note that you will need to include a copy of your most recent federal tax return. If you did not file a federal tax return and/or have no other documentation of income, you can check the box in section 2 on the Alternative Documentation of Income form (ADOI), stating that you have no taxable income. Your IBR application cannot be processed without the ADOI form and the necessary documentation.

Your account is presently in a suspend status pending receipt of your Ford application and forms. Because your adversary proceeding is over, federal regulations require ECMC to pursue collection. ECMC will keep your account in a suspend status until January 1, 2013. If we have not received the application and other forms from you by that date, ECMC will assume that you do not intend to consolidate your loans at this time and will pursue collection from you. You may still consolidate your loans once the account goes into collections.
