as follows:

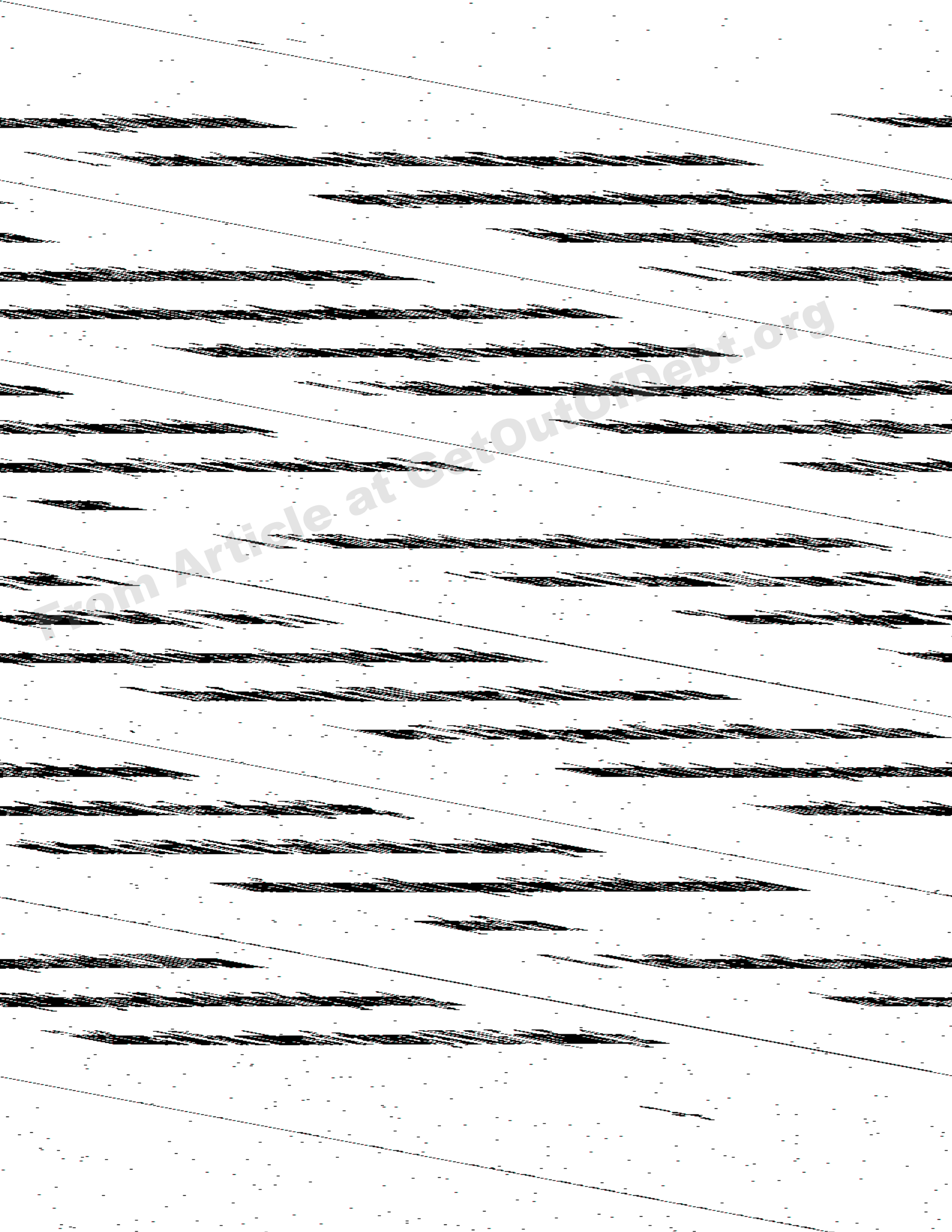

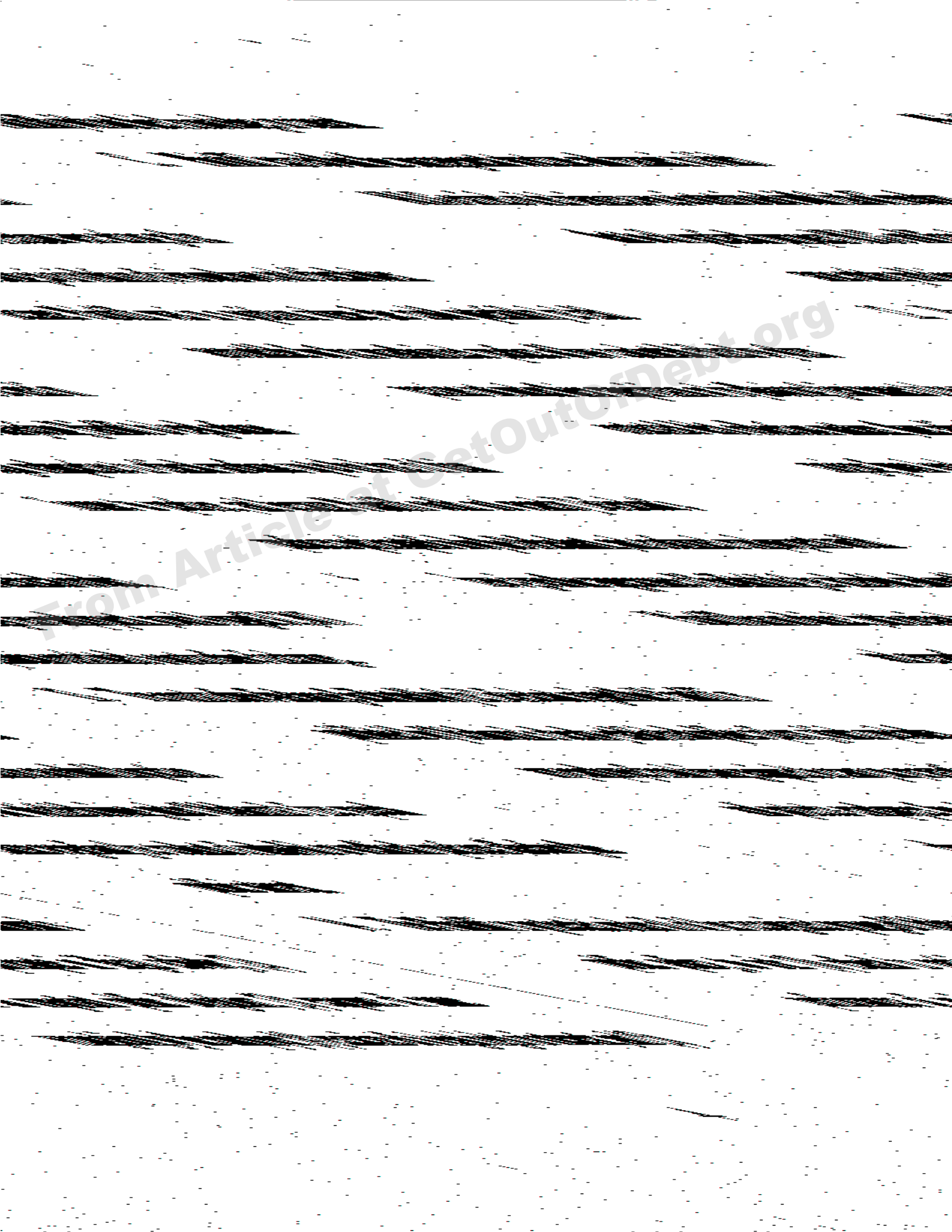
1. The Plaintiff is Heather Weaver, an adult resident of Oklahoma County, Oklahoma.

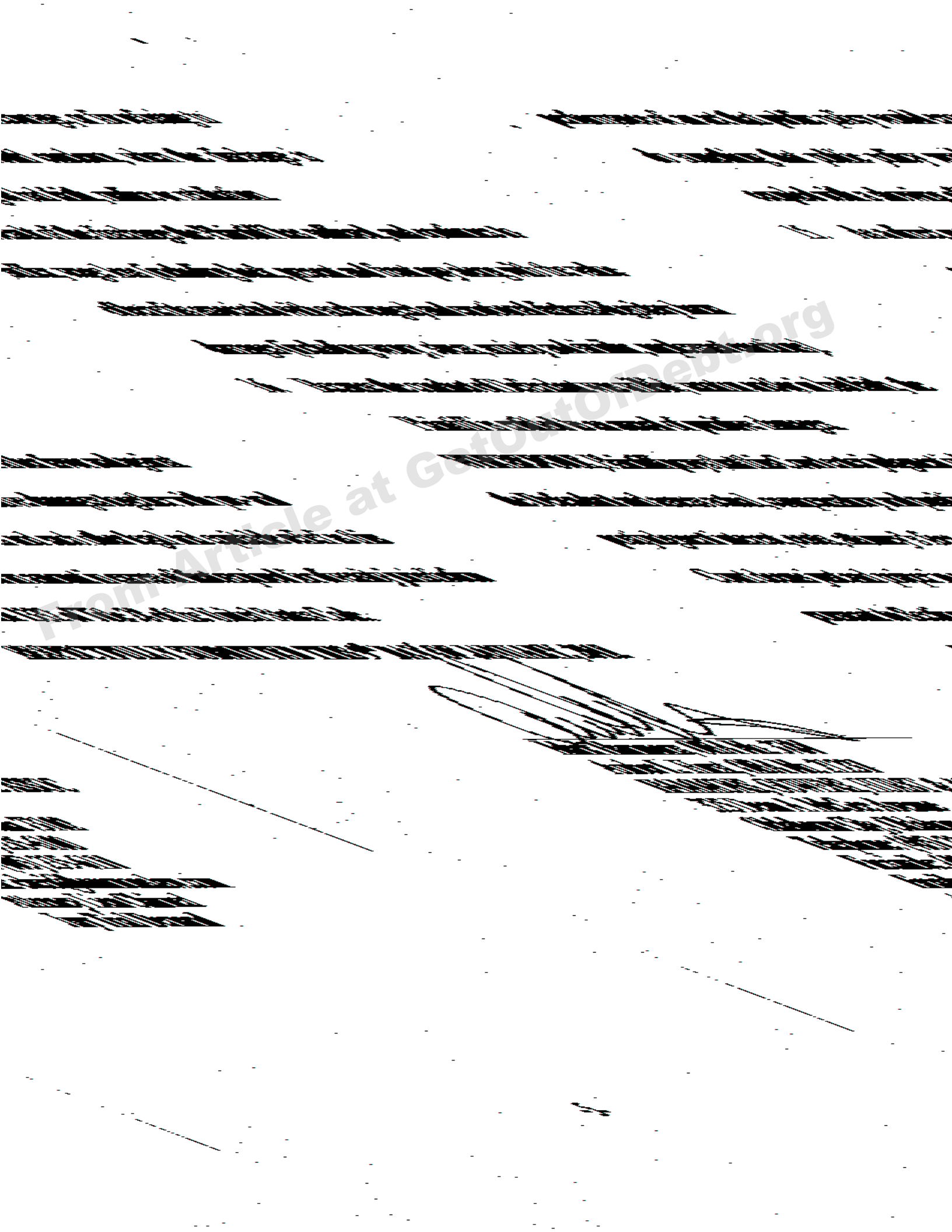
VENUE
