**ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT STIPULATION RESOLVING
ADVERSARY PROCEEDING NO. 18-80004 AS TO
DEFENDANT FREEDOM DEBT RELIEF, LLC**

On March 26, 2018, Plaintiff Trustee Jeff A. Moyer and Defendant Freedom Debt Relief, LLC filed a document entitled "Settlement Stipulation Resolving Adversary Proceeding No. 18-80004 as to Defendant Freedom Debt Relief, LLC". Trustee served the motion pursuant to LBR 9013. Trustee has also submitted an affidavit of no response pursuant to that local rule.

Under the terms of the settlement stipulation, the Plaintiff Trustee and Defendant Freedom Debt Relief, LLC agree that the Defendant will turn over a one-time lump sum amount of \$1,826.61 (the "Settlement Amount") to the Trustee and estate within 15 days of entry of this Order approving the settlement stipulation in full satisfaction of any and all claims the estate may

have against the Defendant. The Plaintiff Trustee agrees to dismiss the Adversary Proceeding as to Defendant Freedom Debt Relief, LLC with prejudice upon receipt and honor of the settlement payment from Defendant Freedom Debt Relief, LLC.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Settlement Stipulation Resolving Adversary Proceeding No. 18-80004 as to Defendant Freedom Debt Relief, LLC is **APPROVED**.


