Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission"),  
having filed and served upon Defendant Johnson a Summons and  
Complaint in this action; Johnson having admitted service upon  
him of the Summons and Complaint in this action and the  
jurisdiction of this Court over him and over the subject matter  
of this action; having been fully advised and informed of his  
right to a judicial determination of this matter; having waived



the entry of findings of fact and conclusions of law as provided by Rule 52 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure; having consented to the entry of this Final Judgment Of Disgorgement And Civil Penalties Against Defendant Jeremy Johnson ("Final Judgment"), without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint except as specifically set forth in the Consent Of Jeremy Johnson To Entry Of Final Judgment Of Disgorgement And Civil Penalties ("Consent"); and no notice of hearing upon entry of this Final Judgment being necessary:

I.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant Johnson pay disgorgement in the amount of \$315,919.82, representing his ill-gotten gains as a result of the conduct alleged in the Complaint, together with prejudgment interest thereon in the amount of \$56,687.07, for a total of \$372,606.89.

II.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant Johnson is assessed, and shall pay to the Commission for delivery to the United States Treasury, a civil penalty in the amount of \$55,000 pursuant to Section 20(d) of the Securities Act, 15 U.S.C. § 77t(d), and Section 21(d)(3) of the Exchange Act, 15 U.S.C. § 78u(d)(3). Johnson shall pay the disgorgement, prejudgment interest, and civil penalty within sixty days of the entry of this Final Judgment. Payment shall

be made by cashier's check, certified check or postal money order made payable to the Securities and Exchange Commission, and shall be transmitted to the Comptroller, Securities and Exchange Commission, Operations Center, 6432 General Green Way, Stop 0-3, Alexandria, Virginia 22312, under cover of a letter that identifies the defendant, the name and case number of this litigation and the name of the court. A copy of the cover letter and the check or money order shall be simultaneously transmitted to counsel for the Commission at its Los Angeles office, located at 5670 Wilshire Boulevard, 11<sup>th</sup> Floor, Los Angeles, California 90036.

III.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction over this action for all purposes, including to implement and enforce the terms of the Final Judgment Of Permanent Injunction And Other Relief Against Defendants Jeremy Johnson and RumorSearch.com, Inc. entered May 7, 2001, which Judgment remains in full force and effect; this Final Judgment; and all other orders and decrees which have been or may be entered in this case, and to grant such other relief as this Court may deem necessary and just.
